#### Monthly: Door gasket; valve assembly

- Open the dispenser door and inspect the door gasket to make sure that there are no cuts or gaps.

- 2. Spray a sanitized towel with KAY® Peroxide Multi-Surface Cleaner & Disinfectant Solution and wipe the gasket clean. Use a small brush to reach all corners and crevices.



- 3. Allow to air-dry.

- Remove the product case with empty product bag from the product compartment.






8. Remove the plunger by pulling it straight out.




9. Wash, rinse, and sanitize the valve insert and plunger in the 3-compartment sink. If required, use a small brush for a more thorough clean.






- 10. Allow to air-dry.
- 11. Wipe the inside and outside of the valve block with a sanitized towel sprayed with KAY® Peroxide Multi-Surface Cleaner & Disinfectant Solution. If required, use a small brush to reach all the corners and crevices that are inside and underneath the valve block.



- 12. Allow to air-dry.
- Discard the towel into the soiled towel bucket immediately after use.

 Push in the plunger and reinstall the valve insert back up into the valve assembly.

19. Turn on the dispenser.
